Hello Artists, Craftsmen, and Vendors!

We are pleased to invite you to participate in the 30th Annual Big Sky celebration of music, arts, and community. The Country Fair and Arts Festival will be held in The Big Sky Town Center again this year, the new location that was designated last year. The event is going to take place on **Saturday, July 31st, 2010**, and our hope is to get as many of our past artists and craft vendors returning, while attracting some great new vendors as well. We hope that some of our event improvements will encourage you to participate in our community art celebration, the *Country Fair and Arts Festival*.

Last year, the fair attracted many locals and regional visitors, as well as visitors from farther distances already vacationing in Big Sky. Last year's fair was said to be the best yet, and this year we hope for an even bigger crowd.

Activities throughout the day include a 5K race, parade, live music, children's activities, great food and fun for the whole family. Without a doubt, the artist and craft vendor sales are always the main attraction, and we are proud to offer more and more craftsmen and artisans each year with a wide variety of great talents and specialized items.

We have the fee schedule set up according to the size of the booth you require:

10 ft. x 10 ft. \$70

10 ft. x 20 ft. \$90

Booth spaces are offered on an as-available basis, and an additional \$10 fee will be assessed if registering after July 23rd. Booth spaces are non-refundable if canceled within 7 days of the event. Any cancellations prior to this time will be refunded 50% of the paid registration fee.

We will begin **set up this year at 7:30 a.m.** (The area will be blocked off prior to then, so please do *not* attempt to arrive earlier). No vehicles will be allowed in the immediate area once the grounds **open at 10:30 a.m.** The festival will run **until 4:30 p.m.** and **no vehicles will be allowed within the festival area before that time.** As always, each vendor is responsible for providing their own table and/or means of display and shelter.
