## Steps forward:

1. Get permission from the power company or DoT (with help from Cleanslate) and BSCC.
2. Raise \$\$\$ needed. \$450 is the estimate for the size of the box at the Big Sky turnoff from the highway.
3. Invite local artists to submit work through various local organizations email lists and websites (Town Center, Chamber of Commerce, BSCC, School District, Crail Ranch, etc). The artwork to be used would be selected by the Boards of these organizations.
4. Send Cleanslate a high res file of the chosen artwork (I can take the image).
5. Cleanslate prints and installs.
6. Continue the project into the Town Center and Big Sky's parks and trails.
